

National guidelines – Thailand

In order to comply with national requirements, we are implementing the following further precautionary measures:

Travel	No employees or delegates must enter RelyOn Nutec facilities returning from affected areas defined by Thai Government within two weeks upon return.
Quarantine	If any of our employees'/ delegates co-habitants, such as spouse and children, are placed in quarantine by the authorities, irrespective of the reason or background, then the relevant employee/ delegate must also be quarantined from RelyOn Nutec centre for the same period or a minimum of two weeks.
Social distancing	We are complying with the Thai Government guidance on keeping 1 metre social distance.
Food hygiene	Served individually and in wrapped portions or by one person.
Class sizes	We reduce the number of delegates in classes to accommodate the 1 metre social distance and if required provide theoretical teaching through webinars.
Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment	First Aid practical courses are transferred into individual exercises as much as possible or demonstrations. All practical training is designed to accommodate 1 metre social distancing in accordance with Technical Petroleum Training Institute (TPTI) guidelines. Use dummies for group exercises where applicable.
Cleaning of equipment	We are complying with the national guidelines and the guidelines from the manufacturer to ensure all equipment are sanitised and free of pathogens.
Other national specific guidelines	The use of masks is strongly advised in this part of the world and entry to centres is forbidden unless wearing a mask. Masks will be provided to participants.
