

National guidelines - Denmark

In order to comply with national requirements, we are implementing the following further precautionary measures:

Travel	It is mandatory for persons crossing the border to Denmark to show a negative Covid19 PCR test, not older that 24 hours, before being allowed to cross the border.
Quarantine	<p>Green or Yellow countries It is not a quarantine requirement if you travel on a negative Covid test or are fully vaccinated.</p> <p>Orange or red countries There is requirement of quarantine for 10 days however this can be shortened if a Covid test indicate negative on the fourth day of entry.</p>
Social distancing	<p>We are following the national guidelines keeping social distance of 1 m.</p> <p>Where 1-meter social distancing can't be adhered, facemasks / -shields are required.</p>
Food hygiene	Served with the highest focus on hygiene.
Class sizes	Class sizes adhere to the 1 m social distance requirement within the relevant room, and if required provide theoretical teaching through webinars.
Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment	<p>Practical elements are transferred into individual exercises as much as possible or/and demonstrations.</p> <p>Training (theoretical and practical) is designed to accommodate 1m social distancing. Where this isn't possible personal protection is mandatory.</p>
Cleaning of equipment	We are complying with the national guidelines and the guidelines from the manufacture to ensure all equipment are sanitised and free of pathogens.
