

National guidelines - Denmark

In order to comply with national requirements, we are implementing the following further precautionary measures:

Travel	<p>Employees must only enter RelyOn Nutec facilities returning from affected areas defined by Danish Foreign Ministry if:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The employee has been in two weeks quarantine upon return, or 2. Provides a negative COVID 19 test, taken after his / her arrival back according to guidelines from Health Authorities.
Quarantine	<p>If any of our employees'/ delegates co-habitants, such as spouse and children, are placed in quarantine by the authorities, irrespective of the reason or background, then the relevant employee/ delegate must also be quarantined from RelyOn Nutec locations for the same period or a minimum of two weeks or provide a recent negative COVID 19 test. (max. 7 days old)</p> <p><i>Delegates from high-risk areas defined by Danish Foreign Ministry must either be in quarantine for a period of minimum of two weeks or provide a negative COVID 19 test. (max. 7 days old) before allowed on training.</i></p>
Social distancing	<p>We are following the national guidelines keeping social distance of 2 m. Where 2-meter social distancing can't be adhered, facemasks / -shields are required.</p>
Food hygiene	<p>Served with the highest focus on hygiene.</p>
Class sizes	<p>Class sizes adhere to the 2m social distance requirement within the relevant room, and if required provide theoretical teaching through webinars.</p>
Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment	<p>Practical elements are transferred into individual exercises as much as possible or/and demonstrations.</p> <p>Training (theoretical and practical) is designed to accommodate 2m social distancing. Where this isn't possible personal protection is mandatory.</p>
Cleaning of equipment	<p>We are complying with the national guidelines and the guidelines from the manufacture to ensure all equipment are sanitised and free of pathogens.</p>
