In order to comply with national requirements we are implementing the following further precautionary measures:

Travel	No employees or delegates must enter RelyOn Nutec-Houston facilities for 14 days

Employees or delegates with new or worsening signs or symptoms cannot return to the facility until: In the case of an employee or contractor who was diagnosed with COVID-19, the individual may return when all three of the following criteria are met: at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in
	symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 10 days have passed
	since symptoms first appeared; or
	 If the employee or contractor has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and wants to return to work before completing the above self-isolation period, the individual must obtain a medical professional's note clearing the individual for return based
