

## National guidelines - Netherlands

In order to comply with national requirements, we are implementing the following further precautionary measures: **Facilities in the Netherlands are open for business critical trainings**

<b>Travel</b>	<p>For international travel follow guidelines ministry foreign affairs, concerning risk assessment and advice each country/region. Out of European countries need to</p> <p>For national travel no restrictions set.</p>
<b>Quarantine</b>	<p>As a result of a second wave of COVID infections, the Dutch government has taken more stringent measures. This means that as many workers have to work at home. Travelling by public transport should only be used for living and working (necessary professions).</p> <p>10 days quarantine is strongly advised if travelling from abroad. Or if you being in contact with a person who is positive tested on COVID-19</p>
<b>Social distancing</b>	<p>National guidelines: 1.5m general guideline – No more then 2 persons together</p>
<b>Food hygiene</b>	<p>Pre-packed sandwiches</p>
<b>Class sizes</b>	<p>Max. 12 delegates for open courses except advanced rescue training: max. 4 delegates.</p> <p>Fire Academy groups for outside training have no limits. (facilities are limiting factor.)</p>
<b>Restrictions on courses/ methodology/ equipment</b>	<p>Every delegate will receive at the reception an individual PPE-package containing Facemask and 2 sets of disposable gloves, extra gloves available in all classrooms / cafeteria /</p> <p>Strict social distance of 1.5m</p> <p>For 1 on 1 training (working at height – advanced rescue training, mannequin will be used instead of life casualty)</p> <p>For pool / huet training (max 2 delegates) at the same time, chlorine values will be adjusted to come close to max. level, see advise of CDC on pool water treatment: <a href="https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/water.html">https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/water.html</a></p> <p>Full face dive masks will be made available for divers.</p>
<b>Cleaning of equipment</b>	<p>Umonium 38 - disinfectant: see annex umonium Used to disinfect all breathing equipment and other relevant PPE's</p> <p>External cleaning company will also use appropriate product for general cleaning.</p>
